		Investigations into the condition of the Mere culvert to be co- ordinated by Shropshire Council and we will see if we could use some of the neighbourhood fund reserves to pay for a possible survey of the section across ETC land.
		Shropshire Council are currently in talks with Avison Young, the creditors for Pochin Developments to arrange an inspection of the culvert on their property.
